STEPS TO FOLLOW

(It's not necessary to follow this sequence)

- 1. Take Young Eagle Flight (free) through local EAA Chapter (4th Sat. of month at WHP)
- 2. Enroll in Sporty's Learn to Fly Ground School (or another Ground School see #9 below) (Sporty's is free for Young Eagles; see link in www.youngeagles.com or call 800-843-3612)
- 3. Sign up for Learning for Life Aviation Explorers (ask about requirements for taking lessons through Post 747 which pays up to ½ of flight training) www.aviationexplorers.net
- 4. Join EAA (Student Membership) www.eaa.org
- 5. Join AOPA (6 month free membership and free Flight Training magazine) www.aopa.org
- 6. Join SFV 99s Women Pilots (girls only) <u>www.ninety-nines.org</u> or <u>www.sfv99s.org</u>
- 7. Apply for Student Pilot Certificate (see "Ceci's Tips" in www.sfv99s.org/education.php
- 8. Look for and apply for flight scholarships (see "Ceci's Tips" for list of scholarships and more)
- 9. Study Ground School (see "Tips for Ground School" on www.sfv99s.org/educaton.php
- 10. Get endorsement to take FAA Written Exam (after completing ground school)
- 11. Take and pass FAA Written Exam (Required before solo) (Sporty's will reimburse the cost)
- 12. Choose flight school and flight instructor (Explorer Post 747 will pay up to ½ of lessons in airplane at Whiteman or specified flight school after Explorer meets guidelines)
- 13. Start flying lessons (Sporty's provides coupon for first lesson; go to www.youngeagles.com
- Get FAA Medical Certificate (required before solo). Talk to Post Advisor first to make sure there
 are no issues.
- 15. Solo!
- Take short cross country flight
- 17. Take long cross country flight
- 18. Prepare for check-ride oral and practical
- Take check-ride for Private Pilot Certificate
- 20. Do aviation community service throughout training
- 21. Perform activities for Congressional Medal throughout training (Ask Post Advisor for information)
