I made the decision to stay back in ND for the summer to cash in on the good weather and finish two instrument flight courses. Since being awarded the scholarship, I have had a few notable accomplishments. First, I have passed my instrument knowledge exam with a 93%. In preparation for my commercial training in the fall, I decided to begin studying for the commercial written which I have passed with a 98%, one week to the day after my instrument. As for the flying, my training is progressing ahead of the template UND has set for their students. Flying every single day, sometimes twice a day really helps expedite the training process. As of today, I have passed both my instrument stage checks (Part 141 checkrides) which satisfies about 90% of the instrument training required for the rating.
